

## Suites / OSC Uniform Guidelines for Charlotte Motor Speedway

Each organization will be responsible for making sure that their volunteers are in proper uniform, the guidelines are strictly enforced and those volunteers who do not comply will not be able to participate in the event.

Volunteer provides and must wear solid black pants, black belt, black socks, and solid black shoes

- ❖ Solid black Dockers style pants or solid black slacks only
  - **No black jeans, sweat pants, spandex, shorts, skirts, Capri pants, or cargo pants these are strictly forbidden**
  - **Pants must be worn up on the waist with a black belt.**
- ❖ Shoes solid black in color, slip-resistant, closed toe and heel (tennis shoes are ok must be solid black)
  - **No sandals, Open toed, flip flops and heels permitted**
- ❖ Suite attendants are required to bring their own "Show Quality" white, long sleeved button down, Oxford style shirt. An apron will be provided.
  - **Shirts must be clean and pressed, and must be tucked in at all times**
- ❖ Runners will be provided a shirt.
  - **Shirts must be clean and pressed, and must be tucked in at all times**

Hair shoulder length must be pulled back and out off of face, must be of a natural color

Mustaches, Beards and Sideburns are acceptable but must be neatly trimmed and groomed daily

Finger nails are to be worn no longer than ¼ of inch and well maintained. If polish is worn it must be a nude or cream color, close in value to the group member's skin tone

Deodorant and antiperspirant is required.

Make-up should only be worn to enhance your natural features and to create a fresh natural appearance.

No jewelry is to be worn with the exception of a wedding band and a medical alert tag

- ❖ (Women only) can wear a single earring in each ear no larger than the size of a nickel.
- ❖ All studs and facial piercings must be removed

Tattoos must be covered at all times

Cell Phones and other electronic devices are strictly forbidden on suite level.
